Today I have made the decision to announce my resignation as a Minister in the Turnbull Government.

I have made this decision after speaking to the Australian Federal Police this week where they confirmed that their enquiries may take “several more months”.

I take the view that politics is not about an individual or a career, it is what is in the best interests of the country and it is unreasonable to expect the positions in the Ministry to remain vacant until the enquiries conclude.

I called the Prime Minister this morning to inform him of my decision.

It was an honour to be recognised worthy for inclusion in the first Turnbull Ministry and I thank the Prime Minister for that opportunity.
