



BOOK COMPETITION

TERMS and CONDITIONS

1. METHOD OF ENTRY

Entries to be submitted via NiE online.

To enter, students must write in 25 words or less why they enjoy reading.

Entrants are directed to read and accept the competition terms and conditions.

The student entry must be submitted by 12pm 7 September 2012.

The competition is open to students aged 5 to 18 years of age.

Winners will be notified by Email after the competition has closed.

The 10 winners will each win a book from publishers Random House Australia supplied to APN NiE

All Winners will be sent their prizes via mail and therefore must give a mailing address.

2. DRAWING & JUDGING

Winners will receive reply notification, after the competition has closed, that they have won.

Winners name will be published in the newspaper and online at the completion of the competition.

Unsuccessful entrants will not receive notification that they have been unsuccessful and not won.
