NOTE:

A decision about a minor civil dispute can be appealed to the QCAT Appeal Tribunal but you must first ask the Appeal Tribunal for permission to appeal. To request permission to appeal you need to complete and lodge Form 39 (application for leave to appeal or appeal) and pay the prescribed fee, if any.

The application for leave to appeal must be lodged within 28 days of your receiving the written reasons for the decision being appealed against. If you have received a decision of QCAT but QCAT has not provided written reasons for the decision you may request the written reasons by writing to QCAT (GPO Box 1639 Brisbane QLD 4001 or at enquiries@qcat.qld.gov.au) within 14 days of the date the decision takes effect. A decision takes effect on the day it is made unless the decision states that it is to take effect at a later date or time.

Your appeal does not affect the operation of the original QCAT decision. However in some cases, QCAT can make an order staying, or temporarily stopping, the decision from being carried out until the appeal has been finalised. If you wish to apply for a stay of the QCAT decision you must complete and lodge Form 44 (application to stay a decision) at the same time you lodge Form 39.
