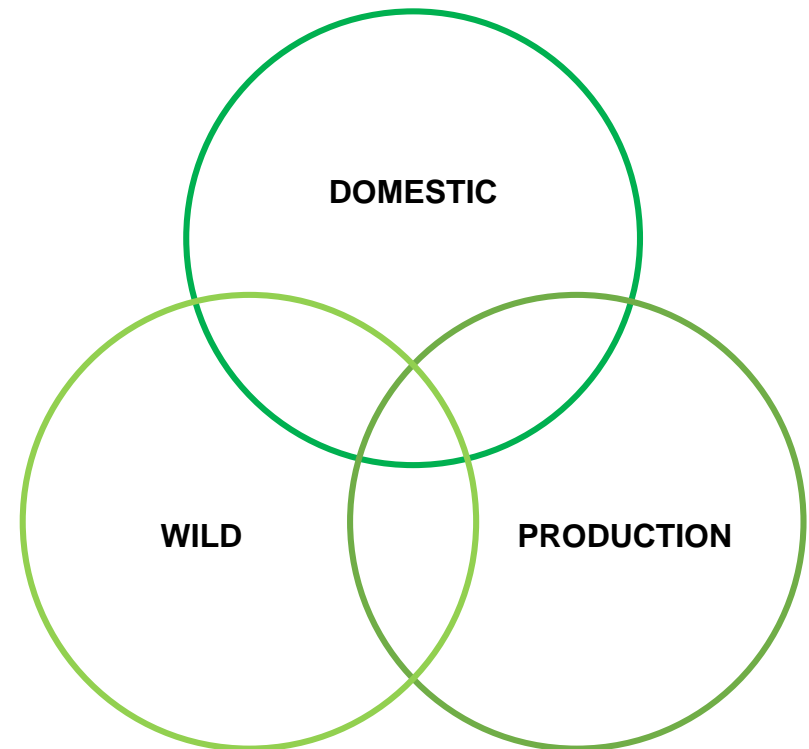
### CREATURE CATEGORY

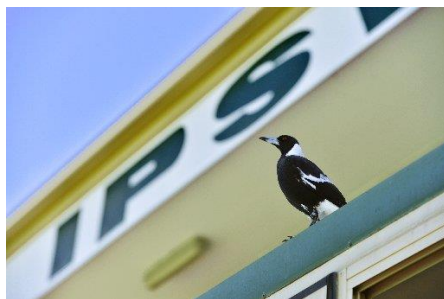

#### ~~Caught out for canine cruelty~~

She was found guilty on both charges and disqualified from being involved in the greyhound industry for two years.

Her inaction over the wellbeing of one of the greyhounds with a gaping "soccer ball" sized wound on its back, led her to appear in court.

Half of the \$2000 fine will be given to the RSPCA.

The woman caring for two dogs faced court on two counts of breaching a duty of care towards an animal.

The court heard that she failed to provide sufficient food, drink and protective apparel to both dogs and failed to provide necessary veterinary attention to the injured canine.

A kennel owner has been fined \$2000 and banned from the greyhound industry for two years after being found guilty of mistreatment of an animal.
